

PROVISION OF PARTNERS AND LATE ARRIVALS

ECBC IS ENDEAVOURING TO BE THE ONLY BRIDGE CLUB IN AUSTRALIA THAT WILL ALWAYS GUARANTEE YOU GET A GAME OF BRIDGE AT ANY OF ITS SESSIONS. 😊
THESE GUIDELINES SHOULD HELP US ACHIEVE THAT GOAL!

1. **Players/Pairs arriving unannounced after a session has started will still be allowed to play provided they are filling an existing "half-table". Unfortunately a NEW half table cannot be created since it destroys the current movement and disrupts the play which is underway.**
2. **Anyone who requires a partner needs to advise the director before the session starts.**
3. **Any partnership allocations are totally in the hands of the director and could be changed right up to start of play.**
4. **Should a player who is seeking a partner contact the Director in some way prior to play starting, it will be deemed he/she has arrived at the club by the start time and a partnership arrangement will be made wherever possible.**
5. **Individuals or Pairs who suddenly expect to arrive late (due to traffic conditions or other unforeseen circumstances) may still play after late arrival provided they have contacted the director by phone (0405-101-729) before play has started (even if this creates a half-table).**
